FOUNDATION HISTORY

The first mission of the Foundation traces its roots to the 1970's and the Association's collection of donations earmarked for college scholarships, which grew into a fund with ever increasing number of awards. With 9-11 and the War on Terror in full swing, the 173d Airborne Brigade jumped into Iraq and the Foundation mission adapted to those needs. The Foundation was formed in 2006 as an independent 501(C)(3) organization with a broader scope in honoring and supporting past, present, future generations of Sky Soldiers and their families. The Sky Soldiers Foundation and the 173d Airborne Brigade Association operate as full partners in delivering support to the members of the Sky Soldier Community.

FUNDS AND SUPPORT MISSIONS

General Assist Fund

This fund receives all non-designated donations

It is used to fund support for stateside families of the active duty Sky Soldiers of the 173d Airborne Brigade. Also used to cover the operational expenses of the organization as well as all requests for support that do not fall under any of the other Foundation funds.

This fund can have temporary dedicated fundraising subaccounts such as in case of catastrophic Sky Soldier or family member illness or accident, natural or manmade disasters, golf outings or tournaments.

Distribution from this fund can be made to the other funds in case of unusual demand on any of them.

Gold Star Assist Fund

This fund is dedicated to supporting the Gold Star family members in a variety of forms. It is to be used to support them in their immediate time of need and beyond, keep close and within the Sky Soldier community, and to give them access to events where the Association gathers in order to present opportunities to meet Sky Soldiers who had served with their loved ones as well as find and offer mutual support with other Gold Star families.

Scholarship Fund

This fund reaches out across generations of Sky Soldiers and delivers our gratitude to active duty or separated Sky Soldiers themselves as they pursue a path to grow in their careers and it also extends to their immediate families. Earnings from Sky Soldier couple's substantial endowment will fund additional scholarships for current and future generation Sky Soldiers and their families.

Sky Soldier Assist Fund

This fund is dedicated to support the Sky Soldiers on active duty and their families who reside wherever the Brigade is headquartered or deployed. The fund is directed by a Foundation Vice President who themselves are with the Brigade HQ, either on active duty or who had served with the 173d Airborne Brigade and now work in direct support of the Brigade HQ and live nearby.

Veteran Sky Soldier Assist Fund

This fund supports members of the Association and Sky Soldiers who left active duty service and their families. The Foundation provides support during their challenging times and as an extension of the local Chapter's functions and members participation. It is a long term relationship through the cycle of life, living the commitment to never abandon each other.

Wounded Sky Soldier Fund

Once a Sky Soldier is wounded and evacuated out of the Combat Theater, when the Unit notifies the family and the Association, the Foundation comes on board. This fund is dedicated to facilitate resources not otherwise provided in the care of the Sky Soldier or his immediate family. The Foundation comes in as a partner to the Association, in particular the local Chapter and its members, in contributing to the Sky Soldier's healing and recovery and their family's ability to support their loved one. The families also have access to direct assistance from the Foundation.


Since our 173d Airborne Brigade is the first line of defense and can deploy on less than 24 hour notice, the Foundation has to build up substantially a reserve fund to support our active duty Sky Soldiers and their families. Those moneys will be committed to cover needs of the Wounded Sky Soldier Assist Fund, the Sky Soldier Gold Star Assist Fund and Sky Soldiers Assist Fund. An application for assistance is part of this reference guide.

The Sky Soldier Gold Star Family program held at each reunion needs help to reach out to the family members of Sky Soldiers killed while serving with the Brigade. We ask each Chapter to assist the Gold Star Family members to register with the Foundation using the form with this article or online. Staying in touch with them and connecting them with other Sky Soldier Gold Star Family members as well as those who served with their loved one brings them some closure and a path to healing for all involved.



Each fund Vice President works with the members of that fund support group at each chapter through fund's chapter chairman

Fund General Operating Guidelines

Each fund Vice President and his team, including association chapter members will be responsible for raising money for their fund, quantify and verify needs and submit fully documented applications to Executive Vice President for review/submission to Executive Committee for final evaluation and payment approval.

All applications for assistance have to be fully completed and submitted electronically, verified and no promise of assistance can be made to anyone without a final Executive Committee action with allocation of funds Each fund Vice President will submit fundraising plans to the Executive Vice President for review and then for final approval by the Executive Committee All business can be conducted via e-mail and/or teleconference, all voting to be recorded via email on actions taken by the Fund Executive Committee

2019 DONATION OPPORTUNITY ALERT to Association members, their families and friends through the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC)

The Sky Soldiers Foundation has been approved by the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) as a charity that can receive donations from those serving in the military, federal employees, government contractors, as well as both military and federal retirees, through payroll deductions, either through one time or recurring monthly payments. The Foundation's CFC ID # is **41126**

We invite all who serve with the 173d Airborne Brigade or its supporting units, have served and are either still in the service or working for the federal government in some capacity, to consider donating to the Sky Soldiers Foundation through the CFC charity giving program at https://cfcgiving.opm.gov/welcome . All donations will be supporting the Foundation's mission to serve the Sky Soldier community – benefiting our active duty Sky Soldiers, Fallen's (Gold Star) families, Wounded Sky Soldiers, Veteran Sky Soldiers, and their respective families.

We also ask all Sky Soldiers, if you have family members and friends who serve in the military or work for the federal government, please champion with them the role of the Sky Soldiers Foundation in the Sky Soldier community and to ask them to consider donating to the Foundation through the CFC. Others can donate directly through our website or by mail-in form found there.

One major program that the Foundation supports is the awarding of scholarships in a competitive selection process to deserving individuals pursuing an accredited undergraduate or post-graduate degree through a technical education institution, community college, college or university. Scholarship applicants or their sponsors are required to be members of the 173d Airborne Brigade Association. Membership is not required of fallen Sky Soldiers families. Those eligible are:

- (1)Current active duty Sky Soldiers, their spouses, and children
- (2) Active duty and past Sky Soldiers, their spouses, and children
- (3) Fallen Sky Soldiers [Gold Star] spouses, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren
- (4) Veteran Sky Soldiers, their spouses, children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren

Another significant Foundation role is facilitating fallen Sky Soldiers (Gold Star) family members attendance at 173d Airborne Brigade Association reunions. Participating at these events presents an opportunity to meet and learn from those who had served with their loved one, help them find closure. It helps create bonds with other Sky Soldier Gold Star families, finding mutual support.

2019 SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

Marlene Battelle-Hummell, Foundation Advisory Board and Scholarship Committee Member

The Sky Soldiers Foundation Scholarship Program awards are a living memorial to the Sky Soldiers of the 173d Airborne Brigade who made the supreme sacrifice in serving their country.

The Scholarship Program recognizes achievement and provides support to applicants pursuing higher education and displaying the potential to earn either technical, associate, undergraduate or post graduate degrees. These degrees can be from a range of accredited educational institutions, including technical schools, community colleges, colleges or universities.

In 2019 the Foundation Scholarship Committee received completed applications from 45 candidates, all of whom are to be commended on their goals and aspirations for higher education. For 2019 the Sky Soldiers Foundation awarded 15 scholarships in the amount of \$1173 each.

In addition to active duty military and spouses, the recipients include students in Vicenza Italy (where the 173d Airborne Brigade is based) and all over the United States, from Maryland to Florida to Washington state. Some students are just beginning their post high school studies, while others are working on advanced degrees. Their areas of chosen study vary widely but their level of commitment is apparent. They are the future of our country and we are proud to support them on behalf of the donors from 173d Airborne Brigade Association and within our Sky Soldier community and beyond.

In order to qualify for a scholarship, the applicant or the sponsor is required to be a member in good standing with the 173d Airborne Brigade Association. A Killed In Action (KIA) Sky Soldier's (Gold Star) spouse or his/her direct descendants are exempt from the Association membership requirement. An applicant must be either be a Sky Soldier on active duty, a Veteran Sky Soldier, fallen Sky Soldier's (Gold Star) spouse or their direct descendant. All other applicants must have a sponsor who is serving or has served with the 173d Airborne Brigade, and the applicant must be the sponsoring Sky Soldier's spouse, child, grandchild or great grandchild.

Applicants may apply for Scholarships each year while pursuing studies. Each application cycle remains a standalone competitive process. Application guidelines, deadlines, forms and other pertinent information should be checked for changes and updates at the beginning of each year and up to the time the applicant files his or her application at: <u>https://www.skysoldiersfoundation.org/Scholarships</u>

The process of evaluation of Scholarship applications and selection/determination of the award recipients is done by the Scholarship Committee. Designated members of the committee rate each application on its individual merits without knowing the names of the applicants. Committee members pass their scored evaluations of each qualified application to the Scholarship Chairman and the winners are determined. Depending on the funding available for that cycle, the number of awards are determined. This number varies from year to year based on donations by members and others.

This important program can only continue to function and expand the scope and scale of opportunities we extend to our Sky Soldiers and their families through the generosity of the members of the Association. Please consider a donation to the Sky Soldiers Foundation Scholarship Fund. A gift of any size is tax-deductible and greatly appreciated. 



Gold Star Family Program

History, Reunion 2019, Reconnecting, Planning for 2020 and beyond

The initiative to support the Sky Soldiers Gold Star Family members was brought forth through the vision of the late General John R. Deane, Jr. and Col. Robert Sigholtz and was implement by Judy C. Campbell (Gold Star Sister of Sp/4 Keith Allen Campbell - DSC, BSM 'v', PH - Combat Medic – KIA Vietnam 02/08/1967), who became the first Chairperson of the Sky Soldiers Gold Star Committee. The program was taken over and run by the leadership of the 173d Airborne Brigade Association for a few years. Debora Yashinsky with the support of her husband James (Gold Star Parents of Sgt. Michael Emerson Yashinski – BSM - KIA Iraq 12/24/2003) came on board as Chair took it to the next level by researching and building the database to approximately 1600 family members. That same database was used by the 173d Airborne Brigade Memorial Foundation to reach out to the Gold Star Family members as that project developed and was completed. Under Eric Hitchcock's leadership of the then called 173d Airborne Brigade Association Foundation, Doris Brazzale-Hovis was invited to Chair the Gold Star Family program. She has been its organizer and champion during the past 6 years with the support of her two talented and dedicated daughters. Overall the program has been in existence and active nearing 20 years.

Judy's, Deborah's and Doris's dedication, personal touch and sensitivity to the needs of each Gold Star Family member has continually improved the quality of the event at the reunions and facilitated a mutual support relationship among those attending that extended beyond the time at the reunion. As new Gold Star Family members have joined us at the reunions, where the Foundation has hosted them at exclusive luncheons or dinners, so have Sky Soldiers come forth who had served with their KIA loved one, and have joined the event. Each reunion event being memorable for all participants and a significant contributor to the healing of both the Gold Star Family members and the Sky Soldiers who served with their loved one plus those supporting the events.

At this time a monumental task calls on us to rally together in the effort to reconnect with all Gold Star Family members in the existing database, and update it to reflect the current status of those listed there and add those who should be in that list. That requires the Foundation's full partner, 173d Airborne Brigade Association and its Chapters and members, to reach out and locate those Gold Star Family members and verify their status.

The 173d Airborne Brigade Association 2020 reunion registration has begun and we encourage all Association Chapters and members to reach out to the Gold Star Family members in their area of operation and invite them to attend. Please provide them a copy of the Foundation's Sky Soldiers Gold Star Family Member Registration form included with this Reference Guide, if necessary help them fill it out and send in. Assist them with registration for the reunion with the link and forms, inquire on their ability to attend and need of financial support.
